

Residual Testing Regulations

An on-campus or Residual Testing program is available strictly for colleges that wish to administer the ACT college readiness assessment to their enrolled, admitted, or applicant students.

Results are reported only to the college administering the assessment. You will not receive your scores unless the college provides them to you. No Student or High School Reports are generated, and you may not request Additional Score Reports for any other college.

Testing may be conducted on any date except a regularly scheduled ACT Test Date.

You may not repeat Residual Testing within 60 days of your previous testing

Residual Testing scores are not accepted for NCAA initial eligibility

Residual Testing is not a replacement for ACT National Testing nor is it a practice test for the National ACT.
