## Vikings Surge Past Jewell



**#4 Darrell Madry had 7 receptions for 166 yards with 2 TD's Saturday**

The Missouri Valley Vikings put themselves in a tough spot Saturday, trailing the winless William Jewell Cardinals 11-10 after one half of play. Valley exploded out of the locker room and reeled off 34 unanswered points in the second half to take home a 44-11 win and improve to 5-1 on the season. The Vikings took an early 10-0 lead with a nine play touchdown drive on their first possession and another ten play drive that ended with a 22-yard Adrian Trevino field goal. Three second-quarter

fumbles by MVC led to a safety, a 19-yard touchdown pass from Cardinal QB Drew Witman to Dan Johnson, and a field goal that gave WJC the halftime lead. That would be all the Cardinal offense could generate as Valley limited WJC to only 95 total yards and ten first downs for the game. Colin Smith led MVC with six tackles as the Viking defense allowed just sixteen yards of rushing offense. The Valley running game had a healthy day on the ground, controlling the line of scrimmage to the tune of 197 rushing yards on 42 attempts. Sterling Hardin tallied 122 yards and two scores on 15 carries, and David Allen rushed 16 times for 97 yards. Valley also got a huge performance from junior receiver Darrell Madry, who caught seven passes for 166 yards, including touchdown receptions of 33 and 65 yards. The MVC punt return unit provided a spark, deflecting two punts and setting up a 48 yard return by freshman Deajon Mitchell that led to a score.

MVC will return home Saturday to take on the Evangel University Crusaders in the 2009 Homecoming game. EU is 1-4 on the season and coming off of a 10-6 loss to Central Methodist University. Kickoff is set for 2:00 p.m. at Gregg-Mitchell Field.

### Senior Profile: Scott Humphrey Tight End #6 6-3, 240

Team captain Scott Humphrey is a leader for the Vikings on and off the field. The Salisbury, MO native came to MVC as a receiver and has made a successful transition to

tight end. Humphrey has 29 career receptions as a Viking for 430 yards and two touchdowns. Scott is a Physical Education major at MVC with plans to become a teacher and coach.
