

## Juvenile Literature

### WHERE IN THE WORLD DO I START LOOKING??

This is an introductory guide to reference information in Juvenile Literature. The Juvenile Collection is comprised of over 3,000 volumes covering a wide range of disciplines and subjects.

**The Juvenile collection is housed in the Teacher Education Library and is shelved separately from standard library materials.**

Caldecott, Newbery, and Mark Twain award-winning books are shelved at the beginning of the collection. **Reference books labeled "REF L's" are located in the Teacher Education Library. The "REF P's & Z's" will be found in the Main Library.**

To search the collection or search for juvenile books and eBooks on juvenile literature at MVC, go to the library's web page at <http://www.moval.edu/library1> and use the online catalog Quest. This online catalog allows access to the print collections at several other Missouri academic libraries. Quest can be accessed via any computer that has Internet access.
