# **ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS**

Freshman applicants who meet the following criteria will be granted automatic, regular admission to Missouri Valley College:

• 18 ACT (940 SAT) or higher

■ 2.00 GPA

Top half of graduating class

Students with 27 completed college credit hours, or more, will be admitted if a 2.0 cumulative GPA has been achieved for all coursework. Students with less than 27 completed college credit hours will be admitted based on freshman admission standards.
