ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Freshman applicants who meet the following criteria will be granted automatic, regular admission to Missouri Valley College:

- 18 ACT (940 SAT) or higher
- 2.00 GPA
- Top half of graduating class

Transfer students are admitted based on their academic records from all accredited institutions they have previously attended. Students with 27 completed college credit hours, or more, will be admitted if a 2.0 cumulative GPA has been achieved for all coursework. Students with less than 27 completed college credit hours will be admitted based on freshman admission standards.
