APPLICATION PROCESS

The Missouri Valley College Nursing Program will be accepting MVC student applications through February 1st. All other students must have the application process completed by April 1st. Students meeting the acceptance criteria will be admitted in the Fall semester. Students applying to the program will be evaluated on GPA, references, ACT and TEAS scores. A total of 21 students may be accepted each year. Visit the nursing website for further details.



CLASSES

Nursing classes are held at the SON which is located on the Fitzgibbon Hospital campus. Clinical rotations will require the student to travel within a one hour radius of the SON. This is to assure that there are adequate training facilities to enhance clinical skills necessary to become a safe practitioner.

Missouri Valley College and Fitzgibbon Hospital have partnered to strengthen our nursing program in preparing future nurses to meet the diverse health needs of our local community and around the globe. Other facilities also allow us to use their clinical areas to enhance the student's clinical skills while providing compassionate and culturally competent care. While our focus is on rural health, students will receive education and training in all nursing areas from prenatal to geriatrics.
