ATTENTION STUDENTS!!

Missouri Valley College FALL 2020 [RETURN-TO-CAMPUS INFORMATION]

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE

- The **entire** online check-in form must be completed before you arrive on campus. This includes your down payment.
- Before check-in to housing will be allowed, immunizations must be up to date (including TB screening form), complete with Medical Alert and Consent to Treat forms signed. When completing the expected forms, you will need to be done 48 hours before your arrival.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

- Students must check in between normal business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday Friday.
- No one can accompany students when checking in.
- Only 2 adults are allowed to help move students into the residence hall. No one under the age of 18 will be allowed on campus.
- Students cannot check-in before their corresponding date.

Testing

- Upon arrival to campus and the Malcolm Center for Student Life, you will be tested for COVID-19.
- Students who test positive will either be placed into quarantine housing or asked to return home with their family until they are cleared. Students who test positive will be required to begin the semester online.

COMMUNITY HEALTH [*mask up. back up. wash up. check up*]

Masks/face coverings are required of everyone on campus when not in the privacy of their office or, in the case of the students, in their personal living quarters. Masks must be worn when in hallways, bathrooms, classrooms and visiting other offices. MVC will provide two masks to each student (but you are encouraged to also bring your own).
The best way to prevent the spread of COVID-19 is to help keep each other safe and healthy.

CLASSES

Students will be notified of the plan for each of their classes prior to the start of the first day of class. In general small classes will proceed in a normal, face-to-face fashion (with spacing and face masks) for all class sessions. Larger classes will be taught in a hybrid format, with students divided into groups. Each group will have face-to-face instruction in the classroom at least one day/week and remote synchronous instruction and/or asynchronous learning the remaining day(s) of the week.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS
