The Financial Aid Office will evaluate your eligibility for summer federal aid. NO state or institutional aid is available for summer enrollment.

Students MUST BE ENROLLED in at least 6 credit hours in a degree-seeking program to be eligible for federal Pell Grant and/or federal loan consideration. Private Alternative loans are available based on credit approval.

Students must be making satisfactory academic progress (SAP) at the end of the spring 2019 term for aid to actually disburse.
