

## I-20 FORM & MAINTAINING YOUR F-1 STATUS

When transferring to Missouri Valley College as an F-1 student, you will encounter several steps to maintain your F-1 status and prepare for your studies. The following guide outlines what to expect and what actions are required.

### STEP 1

#### RECEIVE YOUR I-20 FORM

The I-20 confirms your enrollment at Missouri Valley College and maintains your F-1 status.

- Review the I-20 carefully to ensure the following information is correct:
  - Full Name (must match your passport)
  - Date of Birth
  - Country of Citizenship
  - Program of Study and Level
  - Program Start Date
  - Student Funding Information

**Important:** Any errors may delay your visa or transfer process. Contact the International Office immediately if corrections are needed.

### STEP 2

#### SEVIS FEE

- Transfer students do not need to pay the SEVIS I-901 fee again as long as their SEVIS ID has not changed.
- Your original SEVIS payment remains valid once your record is transferred to MVC.

### STEP 3

#### F-1 VISA GUIDANCE

- If your current F-1 visa is valid, you may continue using it when entering the U.S. with your MVC I-20.
- If your F-1 visa has expired and you plan to travel outside the U.S., you must apply for a new visa before returning.
- If your visa has expired but you remain in the U.S. until classes begin, you do not need a new F1 visa.

### STEP 4

#### PLAN YOUR TRAVEL

- You may enter the U.S. up to 30 days before the start date listed on your I-20.
- Share your flight information with us as soon as it is confirmed.
