- TB screening about \$10.00 to \$15.00 each. (Need to have a 2-step or a negative result for two consecutive years and one current. If you have ever had a positive TB contact us.) Cost incurred by the student and is given by Health Department. Must be read by personnel from the agency that administered the initial screening.
- Background check: CertifiedBackground.com. Cost of about \$65.00. This cost is incurred by the student. Need credit card to complete this transaction.
- Family Care registry (State Background Check) Cost about \$11.00. This cost is incurred by the student.
- Student is responsible for attending workshops, lobbying day, and for other learning experiences. (Approximate cost is \$100 per year x 2 years. This is not included in your student lab fees.) (Approximate Total: \$1000.00 + cost of laptop)
